

AN ORDINANCE


POSTING MUNDAY GOLF COURSE AND MUNICIPAL LAKE
PROPERTY TO PROHIBIT FIREARMS AND THEIR DIS-
CHARGE AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED that 131.6 acres owned by the City of Munday, Texas out of Samuel Washburn Survey and of Record in the Deed Records of Knox Co., Texas in volume 74 page 473 & 623 be posted to prohibit any hunting or discharge of any firearm on said property unless in possession of Law Enforcement Officers (the Lake Creek Country Club, Golf Course and City Lake are located on this property).

Any person violating this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$200.00. Each violation shall be considered a separate offense.

Because of imminent danger to life and health of persons using the above described premises for recreational purposes, this Ordinance is hereby declared an Emergency Ordinance and said Ordinance is read, passed and approved on its first reading. Bobby D. Burnett made a motion the Ordinance be passed. Von Marr seconded the motion. Voting for passage were Burnett, Marr, Dickerson, Tucker and Therwhanger. Nones, none. Passed this 9th. day of August 1983.
