

POLICE DEPARTMENT ORDINANCE # 10102006-4**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS
ESTABLISHING THE ORGANIZATION AND GUIDLINES OF THE MUNDAY POLICE
DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 01-1. ORGANIZATION

The Police Department shall be under the direction of a Chief of Police, who shall be hired/appointed by the City Manager and confirmed by the City Council and who is subject to the supervision of the City Manager and to such rules, regulations, ethics and orders prescribed by the City Manger not inconsistent with the City Charter and ordinances, shall have immediate control and direction of such department. The City Manager shall be vested with the disciplinary and termination power of the department. The department shall be composed of the Chief of Police and other officers and employees as the City Manager may determine.

SECTION 01-2. GENERAL DUTIES

1. The Police Department shall be charged with the preservation of the peace and the order of the city, the protection of all persons and property, and the enforcement of all criminal ordinances and all criminal laws of the City of Munday, the State of Texas and the United States.
2. The department shall:
 - a. Suppress all riots, disturbances and breaches of the peace.
 - b. Pursue and arrest any person fleeing from justice in any part of the state or of the United States.
 - c. Arrest all persons found in the act of committing a breach of laws or ordinances, and take the offenders forthwith before the proper court to be dealt with according to law.
 - d. Make complaints to the proper officers of any person known or believed to be guilty of the violation of the City of Munday ordinances or of the penal laws of the State of Texas or the United States.
3. The police department shall also aid in firefighting when so directed by the City Manager.

SECTION 01-3 AUTHORITY TO FURNISH COPIES OF POLICE REPORTS & CHARGES

1. The Chief of Police is authorized to furnish portions of the police complaint report made by investigating officers and/or records to any person who requests such report. The portions subject to disclosure shall be those items indicating the offense alleged, the location of the alleged offense, identification and description of the complainant, the premises involved, the time of occurrence, the property involved, the vehicle involved, a description of the weather, a detailed description of the offense and the names of the investigating officers.
2. There shall be a charge of \$6.00 of each copy of the police complaint report made. Such charge is to be paid to the police department and shall be deposited in the city's general operating fund.

3. The authorization set out in this section shall not apply to reports indicating identification and description of witnesses, synopsis of confessions, officer's speculation as to the suspects guilt, officer's view of witnesses' credibility, statements by informants, ballistics reports, finger print comparisons, blood and other lab tests, results of polygraph tests, refusal to take polygraph test, paraffin test results, spectrographic or other investigation reports or personal history and arrest records of those accused of offenses.

SECTION 01-04 DETAILED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

1. Any and all other detailed policies and guidelines deemed necessary for operational procedures for the Munday Police will be kept in the City Hall vault filed as Police Department 2006.


